




### AARP Livability™ Index for 27713






### Median Estimated Home Value vs. Median Listing Price








### Price per Square Foot of Comps Sold




#### Size of Homes Sold

Sales Count By Living Area






# Number of Bedrooms in Homes Sold






# Education Levels of Population




### Population of Adults by Age Group




#### **Household Income Brackets**






#### **Average Commute Time**




### How People Get to Work
