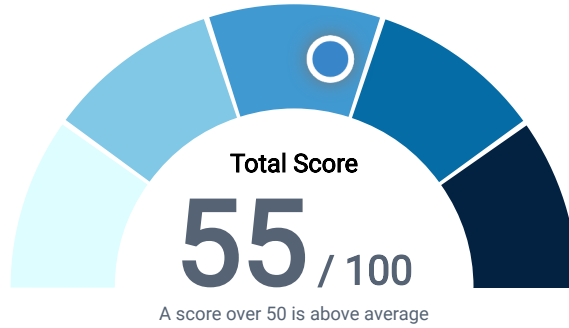

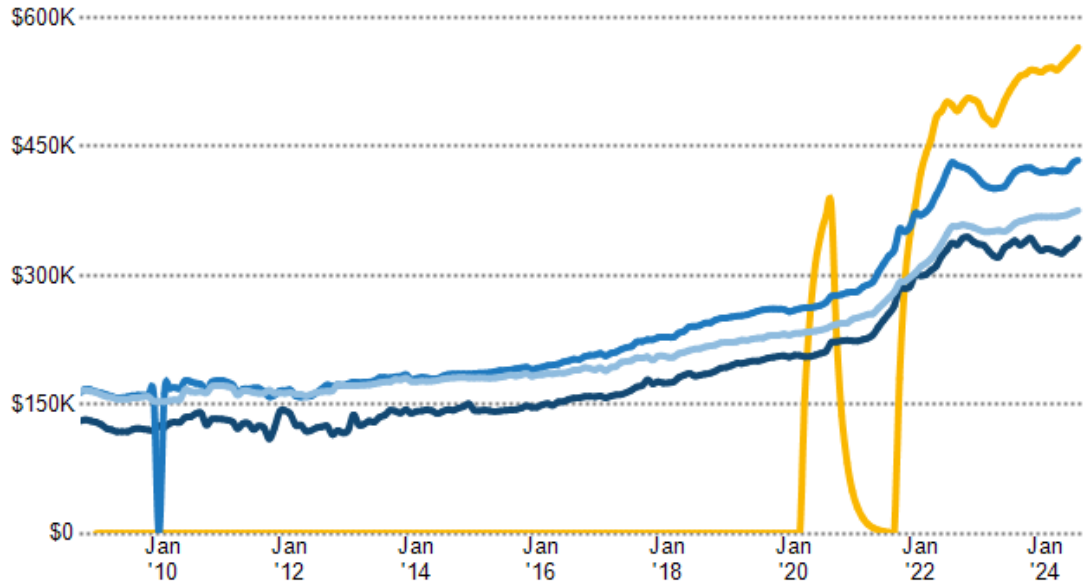

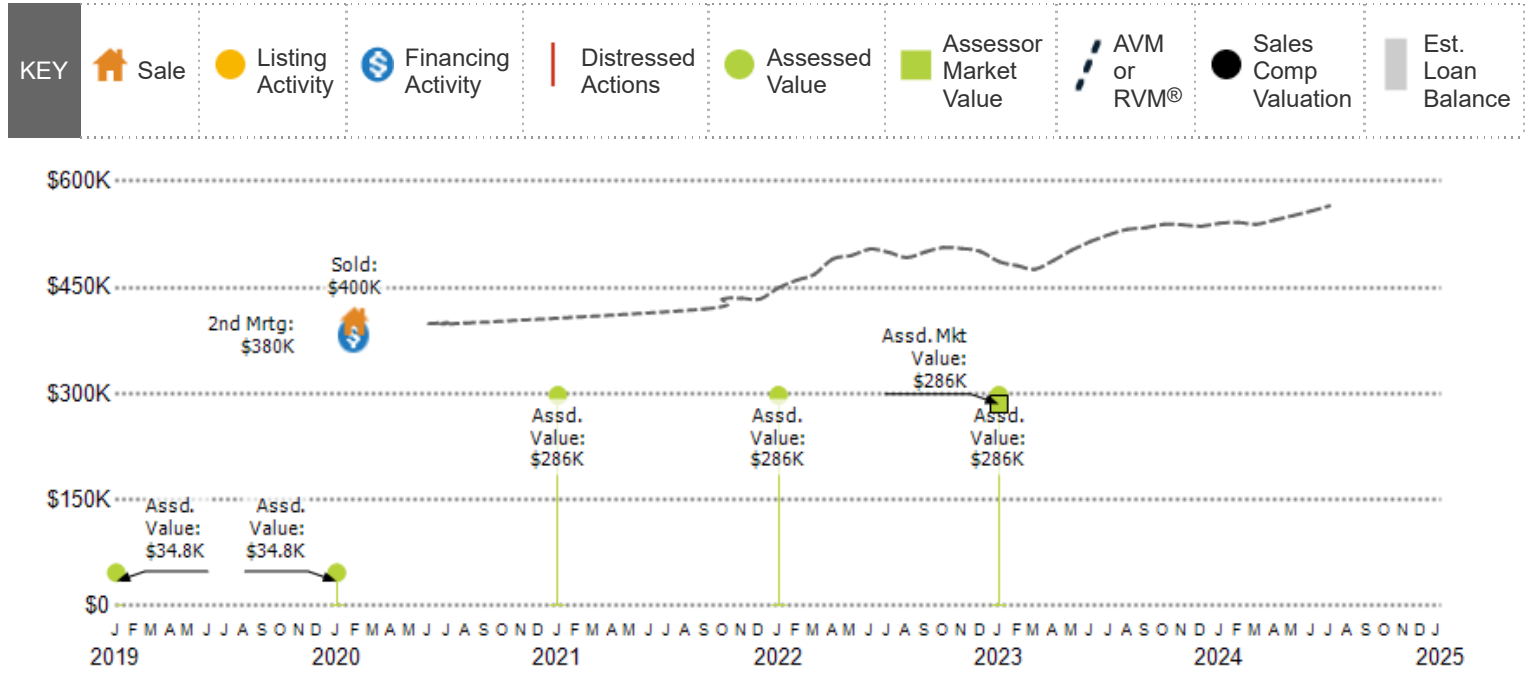

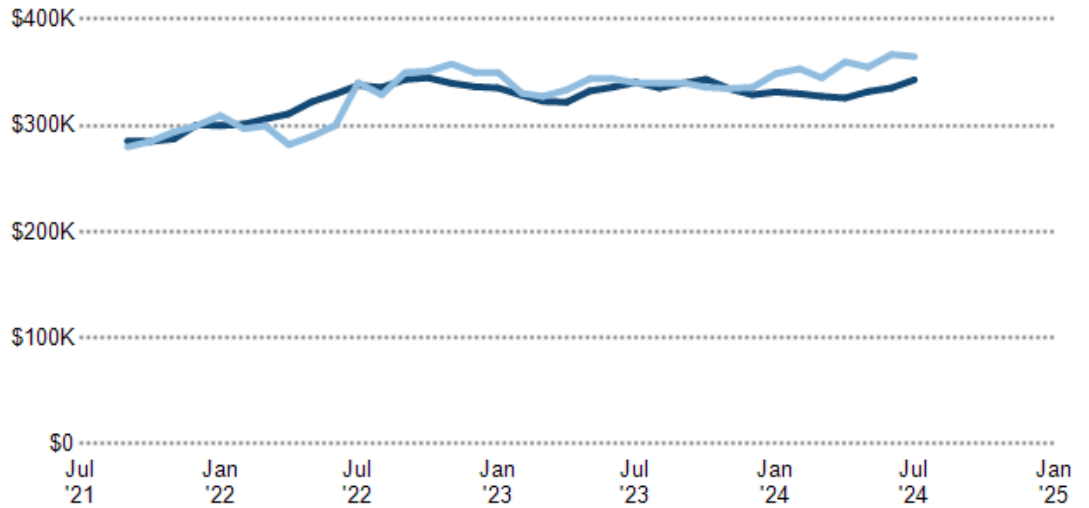
Median Estimated Home Value vs. Median Listing Price

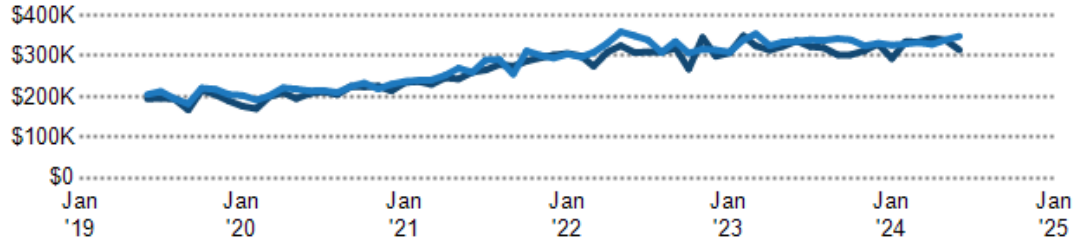

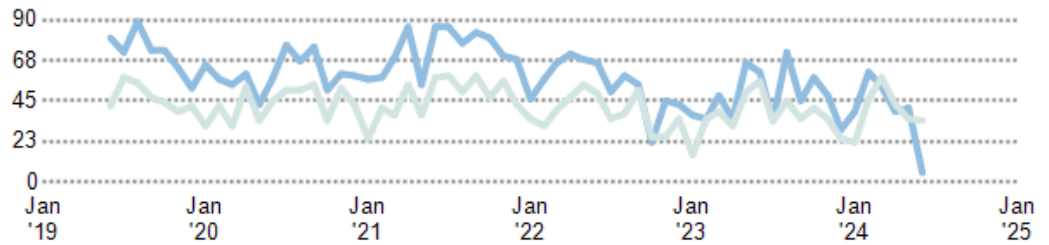

Median Listing Price vs. Listing Volume

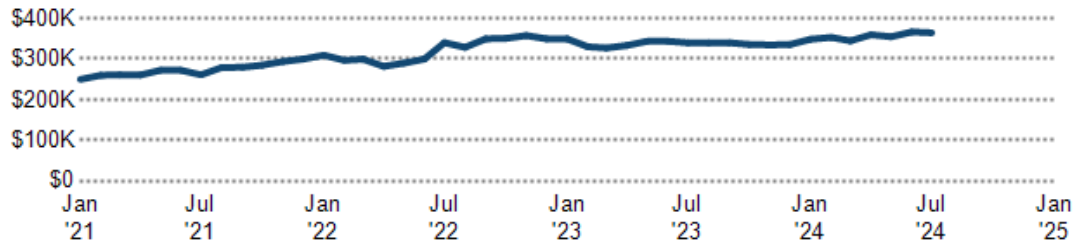

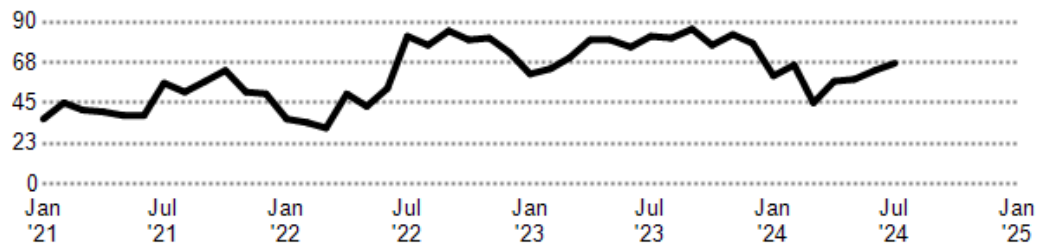

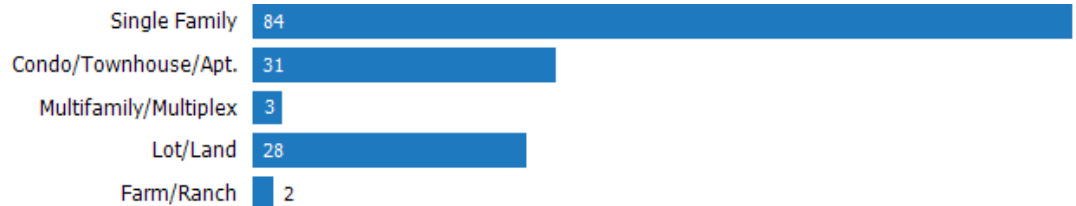

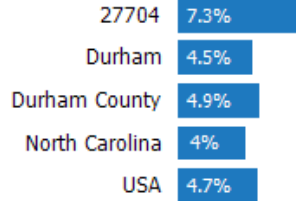

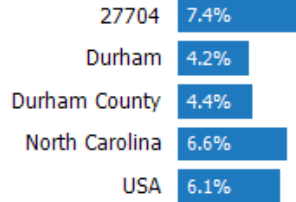

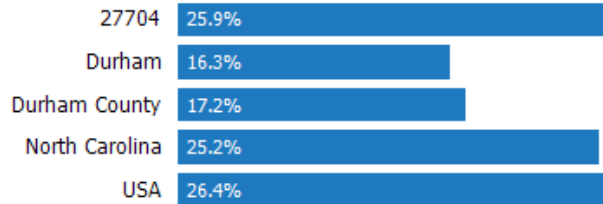

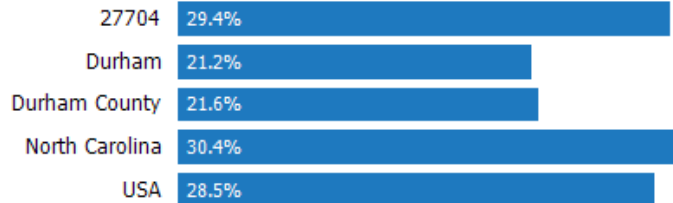

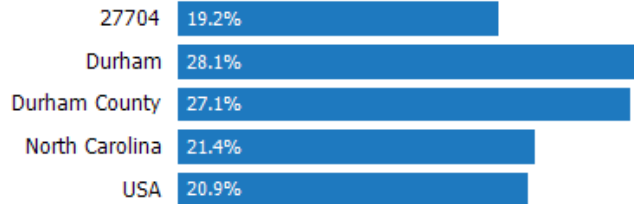

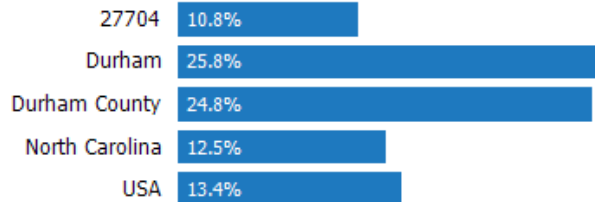

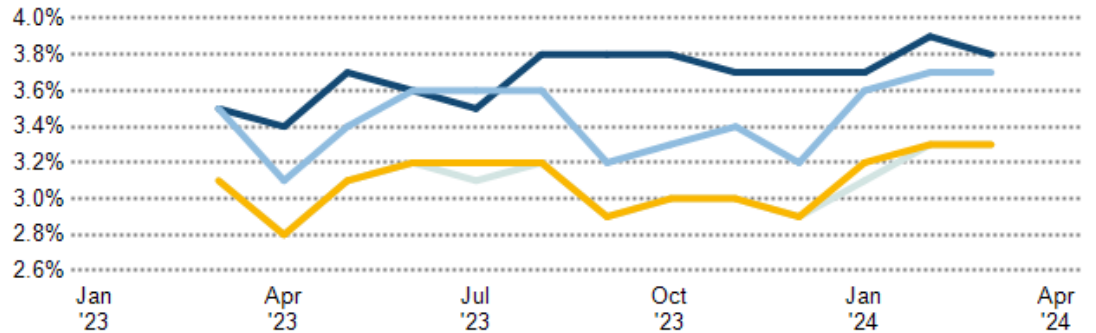

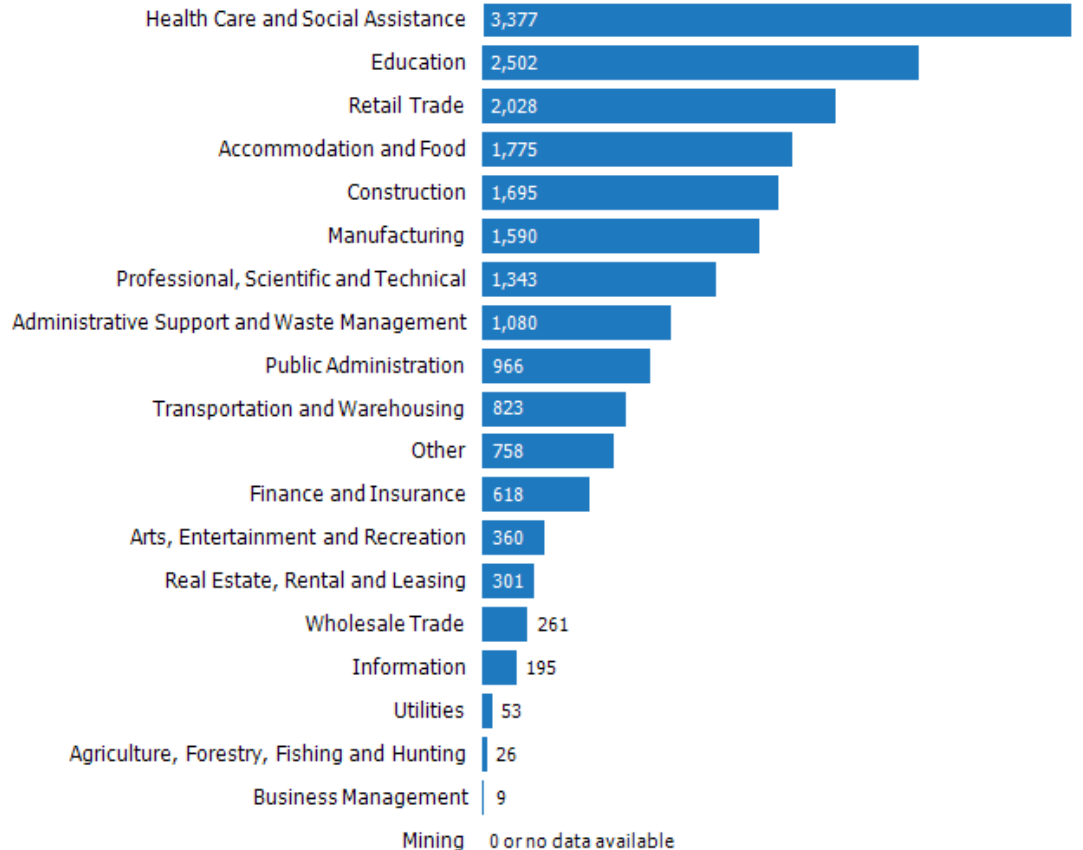
Occupational Categories

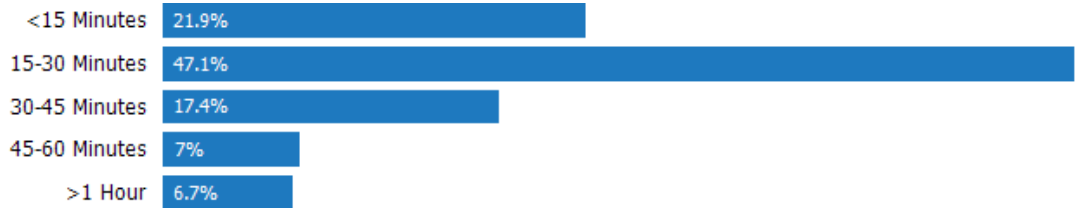
